TO 5 P.M. IN THE OCTOBER THROUGH DECEMBER 2008 PERIOD, KCET HAS HAD A TOTAL OF 5,865 CALLS TO THE HOTLINE, WITH 4,591 INQUIRIES REGARDING CONVERTER BOX COUPONS. DURING THIS PERIOD, KCET PROVIDED INFORMATION ABOUT THE DIGITAL TRANSITION TO ITS VIEWERS IN E-NEWSLETTERS SENT OUT ON OCTOBER 9, NOVEMBER 6, AND DECEMBER 8, 2008, WITH EACH E-NEWSLETTER SENT TO A DISTRIBUTION OF APPROXIMATELY 100,000 PERSONS. TRANSITION, 50% OF WHICH ARE IN THE SPANISH LANGUAGE, AND DISTRIBUTED APPROXIMATELY 40,500 FLYERS TO CIRCUIT CITY STORES THROUGHOUT SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA (60 DIFFERENT STORES IN 5 DIFFERENT AREAS). KCET THEN DISTRIBUTED 50,000 FLYERS TO THE MEXICAN AMERICAN OPPORTUNITY FOUNDATION (MAOF) FOR DISTRIBUTION TO ITS CONSTITUENTS. MAOF SERVES OVER 100,000 CALIFORNIANS EACH WEEK, WITH 95% OF ITS CONSTITUENTS IN THE LOW TO MODERATE INCOME LEVEL.
